Who must obtain TSA Security Awareness Training:

Flight school employees and certificated CFIs: Initial training within 60 days of hire

Each flight school employee and active CFI: Biennial recurrent training
FREE Training available online at: gleim.com/tsa

Student Citizenship Verification Requirements:

- ✓ Verify: Anyone requesting flight training for:
 - Recreational, Sport, or Private Pilot certificate
 - Multiengine, Instrument rating, or type rating
 - Except flight reviews and instrument proficiency checks*

If US Citizen:

- ✓ Document: Keep copy of official verification document for 5 years
- ✓ Endorse Logbook:

"I certify that [insert student's full name] has presented to me a [insert type of document presented, such as U.S. birth certificate or U.S. passport, and the relevant control or sequential number on the document, if any] establishing that [he or she] is a U.S. citizen or national in accordance with 49 CFR 1552.7(a). [Insert date and instructor's signature and CFI number.]"
- ✓ Start flight training

If Noncitizen:

- ✓ Register at www.fts.tsa.dhs.gov
- ✓ Candidate applies for training with TSA
- ✓ Confirm training request
- ✓ Look for preliminary approval
- ✓ Candidate submits fingerprints
- ✓ Wait for TSA approval
- ✓ Take candidate's photo on 1st day of training and submit to TSA
- ✓ Maintain records
- ✓ Start flight training after 30* days since TSA acknowledgment.

*After 5 days if candidate is eligible for expedited processing.
